NOTICE OF RACE

SATURDAY CLUB WINTER RACING SERIES 2022

Start Date: Saturday 9TH April 2022 Finish Date: Saturday 24th September 2022

The series will be run each Club Weekend subject to suitable weather conditions. Decision on suitability will be at the sole discretion of the Principal Race Officer and/or Committee delegated assistant Principal Race Officer
Championship races will only be run on a Saturday. That is if Club Day is changed to Sunday when weather conditions are more suitable on that day there will be no Championship Races that weekend.
Competition will be run on the first four Saturday's of each month.
Racing may be suspended on weekends that clash with major BAI or other Club events at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer and/or Committee delegated assistant Principal Race Officer

Entry Fee: No entry fee

The racing will be in three divisions:

Lights: Under 85kg

Heavies: 85kg and Over.

Cruisers:

1. Youth Members - Under 19 at 1st April 2022 (i)
2. Adult Members - Sailors new to Blokart Sailing who have not had a podium finish at a Club or National event. (ii)
3. Social Division - Members who do not wish to sail competitively. *(Note: Race results will show on speedhive however, there will be no competition results for this group)* (iii)

(Tandem karts will be allowed when the pilot of the second Kart is either partially disabled or partially sighted. For Light & Heavy divisions the division will be decided on the average weight of the two pilots)

Format:

- 2 Minute Dial Up (May be changed on the day)
- 5 Minute Race (May be changed on the day)
- Course and Start sequence will be outlined at the briefing.
- Blokarts will be lined up in a grid ready to race prior to their count down time to assist with a quick turn over of races.
- Drop 1 race after each 3rd race.
- Qualifying races will normally be run between 1.00pm and last race starting no later than 4.30pm. This may be changed on the day by the Race Officer.
- A maximum of 5 qualifying races on any one day.
- Two or more divisions may race together when numbers allow. This will be advised by Race Officer on the day.
- Race scoring will be electronic and transponders will be required.
- Any competitor that is required to miss a race/races because they are involved on official club business that has been approved by the PRO and/or Assistant PRO will be allocated points for the missed race/races based on the average of the last five races they competed in or the points for last position in the race/races missed whichever is the lower.

Rules:

- BAI rules will apply (Any Rules may be over ridden by the Race committee to suite track and weather conditions)
- PRO and/or Assistant PRO may set a maximum time for completion of a race. This will be covered in the days briefing.
- Scoring in terms of BAI v8 Section (H) to apply.

Trophies:

- Only club members (including Associates) are eligible to win the Series trophy.
- Trophy will be awarded based on the total points earned for the series
- Each Division to have up to three placings medals in addition to the trophy for the winner.
- A Club Champion will be awarded for both the Heavy & Light Divisions
- Cruiser Division participants will not be eligible for the Club Champion award.

- (i) A youth member can choose to move to the appropriate weight division if they wish. This to be advised to the PRO prior to the start of the Summer Series.
- (ii) A qualifying cruiser adult member can choose to move to the appropriate weight division if they wish. This to be advised to the PRO prior to the start of the Summer Series.
- (iii) Any member wishing to move from a weight division to the social cruiser division can do so at any time by advising the PRO.
